Andrew Petrou, the Executive Director of Downsview Aerospace Innovation and Research (DAIR) will deliver a presentation on DAIR Hub Phase 1 and 2. The DAIR consortium includes representation from all of the large aerospace companies and leading postsecondary education institutions from the Greater Toronto Area (GTA). Under Andrew's leadership, DAIR has come together with the joint mandate of developing an Aerospace Hub at Downsview Park in Toronto, Ontario. At the heart of the Hub, an Aerospace Research and Innovation Centre will bridge industry, academia, and government partnerships.

Andrew is also the Director of Strategic Initiatives and External Relations (SIER) at Centennial College, one of the academic institutions at DAIR. Centennial's exciting new campus is currently under construction at Downsview Park.

The presentation will also include information on Ontario's aerospace sector and the benefits of clusters, plus an update on the Advanced Manufacturing Supercluster.

Centennial College will be our host for this meeting. Space is limited, so you must register in advance.

Directions:

- From Hwy 401 east, take Markham Road exit, turn left (northbound).
- Turn right at first set of lights onto Milner Ave.
- Turn right at first set of lights onto Progress Ave.
- Turn left at first set of lights into the College campus (PRO on map above) and follow the parking signs to Visitor Parking. Use Lot #2.
- Take a parking voucher from the machine and KEEP IT WITH YOU. If Lot #2 is full, you will need to use the "pay and display" parking (\$3/hour or \$10/day, cash or credit card).
- The Event Centre is an 8-storey building with orange panels on the exterior between the windows.
- Enter the building at the Event Centre entrance on the south side (do NOT use the Hospitality entrance on the east side).
- Take the elevator to the 8th floor (Fall Room)
